CHINA WILL HOST WORLD'S HIGHEST-TRAVELING ELEVATOR

Kone, the global elevator and escalator company, is delivering new lifts and escalators in the super high-rise tower in China. The Finnish company delivers 94 elevators and 36 escalators to be installed in the super high-rise tower of the Chongqing International Trade and Commerce Center located in Chongqing, Southwest China. Kone has not disclosed the value of the order.

Once the building is completed, the Chongqing International Trade and Commerce Center's tallest tower will rise to a height of 468 meters. The 105-story tower will be home to the world's highest-traveling Kone elevator to date.



The Kone Elevators in Chongqing International Trade and Commerce Center will travel to 452m.

DOWNTOWN NIGHTMARE CHICAGO

CHICAGO (FOXNEWS) Imagine being trapped inside an elevator for hours with only limited communication to the outside - more than a dozen people said they were stuck in that kind of nightmare at a downtown condo building overnight.

Rescue crews worked for three hours to free the individuals trapped in the elevator. One individual told Fox News that they had trouble contacting the elevator company to let them know they needed help.

The building at 60 E. Monroe housed a combination of businesses, condos, and office space.

Officials said the group was visiting one of the condos and when they began their descent, the elevator got stuck. It seems the weight of the group may have caused the elevator to malfunction.
